

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Only Buckskin Horses registered with the National Buckskin Society (Inc) or in the Register of other State Bodies affiliated with the Australian Buckskin Association that fall within the Victorian Colour Standard are eligible to compete.
2. All exhibitors must be Financial Members of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) or other State Body affiliated with the Australian Buckskin Association.
INSURANCE - Every participant at this event who will be a handler, rider, driver, groom and anyone handling a horse or pony, must complete an AHSA '**Liability Declaration Form for Affiliates**'. This form, along with the required supporting documentation should then be given to the Secretary of the NBS Inc, or to their delegate at the Show. (Most NBS members have already submitted their form and therefore do not need to re-submit the form again)
Riders/Handlers not covered by NBS insurance must pay on the day Insurance levy.
3. The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the program and to reject any entry at its discretion, if the circumstances arise.
4. The committee of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) accepts no responsibility for injury or loss to competitors, spectators and equipment in any way whatsoever.
5A A **NOVICE** is a horse/pony any age, not to have won a first place at a NBS A/B Class show, a Royal or Agricultural Show.
5B For this show only a foal entered in a Special Class will not lose its Novice status and first time shown status
6. Horses competing in **Dual Registered Classes** **MUST** supply a photocopy of the relevant **Breed Registration and showing proof of ownership**. Only **ONE** Dual Registered class is allowed per horse.
7. A **BROODMARE** must be a minimum 3 months in foal (with a positive test) or have current year foal at foot.
8. Third Generation Buckskin exhibits must be a minimum of 3 **buckskin** generations, which are NBS registered or Registered with another affiliated state body (provided proof of registration is supplied) Please list the 3 horses names & reg numbers on entry form.
9. Approved hard hats ASA AS/NZS 3838, EN1384, ASTN F1163 must be worn whilst mounted & by juniors under 12yrs who are competing in led events and appropriate footwear must be worn.
10. Exhibits eligible for Classes 111 – 117 can only compete in Height OR Age group – not both. E.g. if you compete in the 10.2hh & under classes you cannot compete in the ne 12hh classes or colt, filly or junior gelding classes.
11. High Point Horse of the show is a one horse, one handler / rider combination.
12. Entries in classes 226 & 227 must be in full uniform & carry relevant papers
13. Bred, owned and exhibited by the one person (see definition of Exhibitor)
14. Bred, owned and handled by the one person (must be the registered owner)
An 'EXHIBITOR' is: The person or persons showing the horse. The exhibitor will be the owner, lessee or representative of the said owner or lessee.
A horse can compete in only one of the Bred Owned etc classes
15. Pleasure Horse/Pony must be ridden in a snaffle bit and bridle only. No whips or spurs allowed.
16. All persons handling/riding exhibits at this show must be a financial member of the National Buckskin Society or pay an insurance levy.
17. Same combination of horse and rider CANNOT compete in both Leading Rein and First Ridden Pony



If cancellation of an event is required due to existing or predicted severe and dangerous conditions such as Code Red Fire Warnings/Floods or travel warnings/disease outbreaks, then the following policy will be adhered to:

Cancellation will be decided from the 4-day weather forecast given on the Wednesday prior to the event.

Information regarding the status of the event will be available on the Society's website: www.nbs.org.au or from the relevant contact person.

1. If an event is cancelled prior to the commencement of the event, costs incurred by the Show Committee prior to the event will be paid and the remaining funds will be reimbursed to the exhibitor if the amount per exhibitor is \$10 or more.
2. If an event is postponed, entry fees will not be refunded without a written request from the exhibitor within 7 days of the notification of postponement.
3. If an event has commenced there shall be no refunds.
