


National Buckskin Society (Inc)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Only Dilute Horses registered with the National Buckskin Society (Inc) or in the Register of other State Bodies affiliated with the Australian Buckskin Association that fall within the Victorian Colour Standard are eligible to compete.
2. All exhibitors must be Financial Members of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) or other State Body affiliated with the Australian Buckskin Association.
3. Riders/Handlers not covered by NBS insurance must pay on the day Insurance levy.
4. The Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or add to the program and to reject any entry at its discretion, if the circumstances arise.
5. The committee of the National Buckskin Society (Inc) accepts no responsibility for injury or loss to competitors, spectators and equipment in any way whatsoever.
6. Exhibits may only compete in one Best Presented/Dual Registered class for which they are eligible
7. Approved hard hats ASA AS/NZS 3838, EN1384, ASTN F1163 must be worn whilst mounted and by juniors under 12yrs who are competing in led events and appropriate footwear must be worn.
8. Same combination of horse and rider CANNOT compete in both Leading Rein and First Ridden Pony

- **Completion of this form is compulsory for all persons attending the Barastoc Show NBS Ring. This includes competitors, grooms, and volunteers involved in running the activity.**
- Persons who are not declared attendees shall not be allowed on the grounds or venue of the activity ie. Spectators, unnecessary friends and family members.
- This form must be submitted to the steward on 12th February 2022 prior to entering the ring, so that we have up to date information on people involved in the ring.
- Members are also required to comply with the laws of the relevant State/Territory as at 12th February 2022
- Social distancing of a minimum 1.5 meters is to be observed.
